What is a Civil Renewal of Vows Ceremony?

This is a secular non-statutory ceremony conducted by a Civil Celebrant. These ceremonies can take place in the Register Office or any Approved Venue licenced by the Local Authority.

A Renewal of Marriage or Civil Partnership Vows ceremony is a unique and personal occasion providing an opportunity for any married couple or couples that are in a civil partnership to express their commitment to each other privately or in the presence of family and friends.

This can be a ceremony to celebrate a special anniversary, or if you were recently married or held your Civil Partnership abroad you may chose to have a Renewal of Vows ceremony so that family and friends who were not part of your original ceremony can take part in your celebration.



Your ceremony will be unique to you and our Registration team will assist you in creating a personal ceremony.

A typical ceremony would include a welcome and introduction, readings of your choice, renewed promises to each other, rededication of your original rings or the exchange of new ones.

A souvenir record of the ceremony can be purchased. This is signed and presented during the ceremony.



Where to hold your Ceremony?

For your special occasion, you can choose either the Isles of Scilly Register Office or one of our Approved Premises.

On the Isles of Scilly we have a choice of stunning venues which have been licenced by the Council of the Isles of Scilly for civil ceremonies.

Legal Status

This ceremony has no legal status and is not legally binding to those that participate.

No document issued during this ceremony has any legal status and cannot be used to prove your marital status .

Please note that your marriage or civil partnership certificate will need to be shown before the ceremony can go ahead
