Although I sympathise with the applicants I feel I must object to the planning application on the following grounds:

1. The proposed building would cause the area at the bottom of Buzza Estate to be even more difficult for vehicular access. My mother has frequent daily visits from carers as well as occasional medical call-outs for her poor health.
2. At present the area has a natural flow down the hill but the proposed building would be out of scale with the surrounding properties causing a closed in feel.
3. The proposed building would channel the wind causing a wind tunnel effect potentially increasing the risk of damage to property.
4. We would lose our sea view.
5. The proposed building would be a clear case of overdevelopment which would permanently affect the current boatyard feel of the adjacent green space which is currently enjoyed by many.
