**P/17/060/TWA:** Felling of Elm and Pittosporum on the boundary to the east of Men-A-Vaur due to overshadowing and damage caused to granite boundary wall **Men-a-Vaur**, **Church Road**, **St Mary's** 

Thank you for the above notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated received on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2017.

I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees may hold a degree of amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate and acceptable. The Council do not intend to protect any of the trees further through a Tree Preservation Order.

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees. The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
