Planning application P/18/051 by the Karma Group for six glamping units is not in the best interests of the islands and St Martins' specifically.

My objection to the plan is on two fronts.

Firstly there seems to be an easy assumption that a development on "the back of the island" is not going to change or even spoil the look and more importantly the feel of the island . As mentioned in the application this is in an area of outstanding natural beauty . As such it needs protecting vigorously from intrusion and erosion . The site will have up to twenty four people in and around the hill area changing the quiet feel of the place .

Secondly the applicant states that impact will be minimal . How does the hotel intend to deal with "water in" and "water out"? There is very little information on how they will cope with an increase of about 20% occupancy when it is struggling already with drinking water and sewage .
