Elective Home Education

I understand that you are currently home educating [child name].

The Local Authority has a number of statutory duties in relation to children who are not attending school. This includes the offering of support and guidance to those parents and children who are home educating, and to help you and your child to access a range of services that are available to you. Support and guidance on the Isles of Scilly will be coordinated and arranged by the SEND, Belonging and Inclusion Team.

We recognise that there are a wide range of reasons why parents choose to home educate their children and the dedication and effort required by them to do this. It is important that those reasons are recorded to ensure your choice is truly elective. I have enclosed a <u>reply slip and SAE - (You can email your response if that would be easier),</u> in order for you to share this with us. Our aim is to establish positive and effective relationships with all home educators, and to work collaboratively and openly with them so that electively home educated children and young people on the Isles of Scilly can be supported and are successful.

The SEND, Belonging and Inclusion Team have to work with home educating parents to ensure that that all children of compulsory school age are receiving a suitable full-time education. We appreciate and understand that the level of support required differs between families.

The SEND, Belonging and Inclusion Team will offer support to all parents and their children in the early stages of starting home education and can address any questions parents might have. Where necessary, we will commission suitable external support to work on its behalf

which has a good understanding of a range of home educational philosophies and can offer guidance and support and signpost to other agencies and resources.

Throughout your time home educating, the SEND, Belonging and Inclusion Team will be available for you to contact for any further advice or guidance should you need it.
