THE ST MARYS ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES ORDER 2005

Made under Section 13 of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001

The Council of the Isles of Scilly ('the Council') has made the following Order, in exercise of its powers under Section 13 of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001:

1. This Order may be cited as 'the St Marys Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places Order 2005'. It will come into operation on the 15th September 2005.
2. The Council declares that the area set out in the Schedule and which is coloured purple on the attached map is a designated public place for the purposes of Section 13 of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001. The map is marked 'SMACDPPO 2005' and has been prepared and sealed with the common seal of the Council. It has been deposited at the offices of the Council at the Town Hall, St Mary's, Isles of Scilly TR21 0LW

THE SCHEDULE

1. The whole of Porthcressa Bank from the Porthcressa Inn to the eastern end of Porthcressa bordered by the roadway and footpath to Buzza Square. To include the beach walkway, with the exception of the area in use as a café at the rear of the old fire station.

2. The whole of Porthcressa Beach from a point 80m eastward of the slipway (the former play area) to a point in line with the western end of the beach at Little Porth.
3. From the frontage of Tregarthens hotel to the entrance to the quay adjacent to the Mermaid Inn, including the car park and the road.
4. The whole of the quay from a point adjacent to the Mermaid Inn and including the adjacent slipway.
5. Hugh Street from the entrance to the pier to the 'bank' adjacent to the chemist's shop.
6. The whole of the Town Beach from high to low water marks, Holgates Green, the Rechabite slipway and the pavement of Higher Strand to its junction with the walkway to the Lifeboat House.
7. The footpath from its junction with Higher Strand to the Lifeboat House.
8. The whole of the unoccupied area known as Carn Thomas from the Lifeboat House to the slipway at Porthmellon Beach.
9. The whole of the Carn Thomas playground and youth shelter.
10. Parade Park in its entirety.
