



Recycling Plastic in Scilly

Remember 3 simple rules to recycle right:

- ✓ Items are Rinsed
- ✓ Items are Squashed
- ✓ Fill your bag until full

For plastic that can't be recycled, try reusing it first, or give it away before throwing it away as waste.



By recycling your packaging, you are:

- ♻ Saving carbon (one tonne of plastics recycled = one tonne of carbon savings).
- ♻ Reducing the energy it takes to make new bottles (it takes 75% less energy to recycle plastic than to use virgin materials)
- ♻ You are helping to keep plastic out of the natural environment –helping to save our planet.
- ♻ Some beach plastics are recyclable through the Isles of Scilly Wildlife Trust's Beach Clean Bin Scheme.
