RECITALS

- Council of the Isles of Scilly, Old Wesleyan Chapel Garrison Lane St Mary's Isles of Scilly TR21 OJD ("the Council") is the Local Planning Authority and is considering a Habitat Bank proposal made by the Applicant.
- 2. The Applicant wishes the Council to assess the proposal and enter into a legal agreement to enable the Applicant to Register the Habitat Bank with Natural England.
- 3. The Council may require additional ecology assessment to be undertaken independently and preparation of a S.106 agreement to be undertaken to secure monitoring of the site for a period of 30 years. In return for the promise given by this Deed, the Council will appoint an ecology specialist to check and validate the Habitat Bank proposal and its accompanying documentation and instruct the Council's Legal team to prepare a legal agreement based on the proposal submitted.
