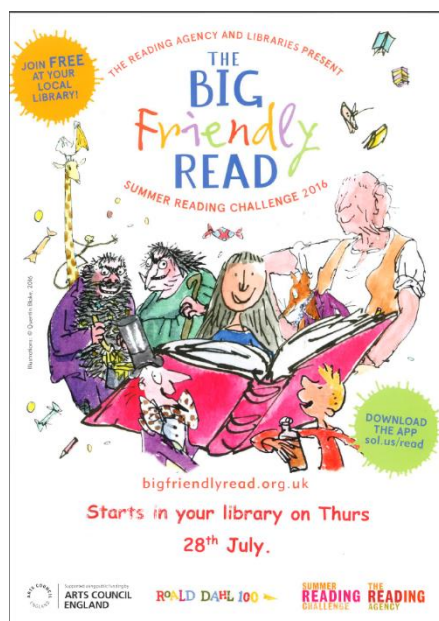

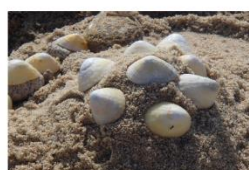
Beach Crafts

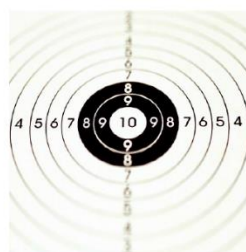

Come and Join us for structured play and swim sessions at Normandy Pool.

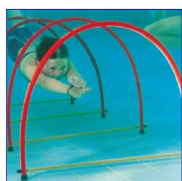

You will need a wetsuit, swimmers, a towel, sun cream and a sun hat, lunch, drinks and snack, warm clothing and lots of energy!

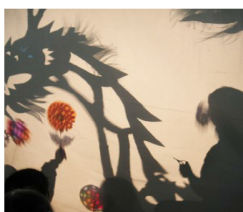

Shadow Puppetry with Reg Payn from Articulate

Shadow play which is also known as shadow puppetry is an ancient form of story telling and entertainment which uses flat articulated figures (shadow puppets) to create cut-out figures which are held between a source of light and a translucent screen or scrim. We will be making puppets and creating our own short films.
