Thank you for your letter of 23 August 2012 notifying us of the application for listed building consent relating to the above site. We do not wish to comment in detail, but offer the following general observations.

### **English Heritage Advice**

The current application is a reduction of the extensions to the quay previously approved. We do not object to the laying of a granite walkway through the area of cobbles which have previously been relayed. Clearly the detailing and actual materials used will be crucial, and we would recommend that this be conditioned. Consideration should be given to whether those cobbles that have previously been relayed, and remain in the current scheme, could be improved.

### **Recommendation**

We urge you to address the above issues, and recommend that this application be determined in accordance with national and local policy guidance, and on the basis of your expert conservation advice. It is not necessary for us to be consulted again. If you feel you need further advice, please let us know why.

Please re-consult us if there are material changes to the proposals beyond those necessary to address the issues we have raised. We will then consider whether such changes might lead us to object. If they do, and if your authority is minded to grant consent, you should notify the Secretary of State of this application in accordance with Circular 08/2009.
