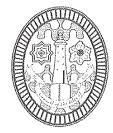

Site and particulars of development: The Harbourside Hotel, The Quay, Hugh Town, St Mary's, Isles Of Scilly - Installation of solar thermal panels; external works, including new bottle storage enclosure, new pump housing and alterations to fenestration; and internal works including reconfiguration of stairwell and 1st floor accommodation and other internal works.

In pursuance of their powers under the above act, the Council hereby PERMIT the above development to be carried out in accordance with the following Conditions:

C1 The works to which this condition relates shall be begun not later than three years from the date of this consent.

Reason: In accordance with the requirements of Section 18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 (as amended) and to ensure that the Local Planning Authority retains the right to review unimplemented consents.

C2 The works hereby permitted shall be carried out in complete accordance with the details shown on the approved submitted plans 1033268/24 Rev B, 1033268/25 Rev D, 1033268/23 Rev B, 1033268/15 Rev B, and 1033268/16 Rev B stamped and dated 10th September 2013.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and in the interests of the character and appearance of the Listed Building.

C3 All external and internal works involving machinery required in connection with the implementation of this permission shall be restricted to between 0800 to 1800 hours Monday to Saturdays. There shall be no works involving machinery on a Sunday, Bank or Public Holiday.

Reason: In the interests of protecting the residential amenities of neighbouring properties.

The solar panels hereby permitted shall correspondence to the precise details as submitted with the application and restricted to a bronzed aluminium frame and the Sahara collector. As soon as the solar PV panels hereby approved are no longer required for their intended purpose, they shall be removed from the building and the roof reinstated to its former condition to the satisfaction of the Local Planning Authority.

Reason: In the interests of the visual amenity of the area, which is designated as an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and Conservation Area, and to protect the character and appearance of the listed building, in accordance with Policy 1 of the Local Plan.

1 Reasons for Approval for Listed Building Consent

Listed building consent should be granted as permitting the proposed works is not considered to conflict with the duty under Section 66 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 to have regard to the desirability of preserving the listed building or its setting or any features of special architectural or historic interest which it possesses.
