Representation:	As owners of Flats 2 and 3 at Two Ways, Rams Valley, some time ago, we were refused permission to replace our windows with uPVC and subsequently had the timber frames refurbished. Whilst there is no doubt that the windows of flat 1 need replacing and have done for some considerable time, it will mean that some of the windows will be timber framed and the others will be plastic. We question whether uPVC will actually match timber frames. Otherwise we have no objections as new windows can only improve the appearance of the property. **Amendment submitted 27/10/2014:** I refer to our comment submitted 26/10/14 and wish to correct a point we made - when we were thinking about replacing the windows in our flat at 2 Ways we asked the council for advice on upvc - the advice was that' uPVC is not acceptable' so we did not proceed with a planning application; we instead had the window frames replaced/repaired.
