Please find as discussed the information required for the plans for replacement windows.

I have also enclosed a copy of the letter re: Replacement of wooden windows with uPVC in the rear of the property "Lyndhurst" which is the ground floor building in our block. This was granted in 2008. I hope with the fact that the building is a first floor property and not at eye level that the view of the windows will be taken into account. The windows we are planning to use are identical in style to the windows already in.

The quote for re-furbishing the existing windows is approximately £1,350.00 which will last approximately 3 years if we are lucky. The wood in the windows is in poor condition and I believe that with refurbishment we would be putting off the inevitable, because the windows are really in a state that they would require replacement.

I would like to ask that the information previously provided (photographs of windows planned to use), used in a recent barn conversion is also taken into account. I believe that the windows will improve the look of the building and reduce the need to keep having the windows re-furbished to a standard that is acceptable to stop the building becoming an eyesore.

I would also ask that the windows used in Trelawney House are also taken into account. I believe that although I was told these have been there for some time that this has improved the look of that building.

I have also enclosed a copy of the quote for replacement windows in wood. Again I am sure you will agree that this is an extremely expensive outlay and considering this it would be out of the question for us. I believe that there are many properties on the Island that are in need of the windows upgrading and this reflects on the properties, by which they become shabby looking and create a poor impression for the Islands otherwise natural beauty.

We hope our application is treated fairly.
