C1 The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of three years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In accordance with the requirements of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended by Section 51 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004).

C2 Notwithstanding the provisions of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (or any order revoking and re-enacting that Order) the use of the field hereby permitted shall be restricted for use as boat storage only and for no other uses within Class B8 of the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 and for no other purposes whatsoever.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt to ensure that the land is only used for boat storage in connection with an existing business and in recognition of the environmentally sensitive and remote nature of the site within the AONB, Heritage Coast and Conservation area.

Prior to the use of the site hereby permitted, details of boundary treatments along the south and west boundaries, shall be submitted to, and approved in writing, by the local planning authority. The scheme shall be implemented in strict accordance with the details as agreed prior to the use of the field for boat storage hereby permitted.

Reason: To protect the character and appearance of the site and surrounding area in accordance with Policy 1 of the Local Plan.
