Proposal: Replacement of front and side elevation windows like for like in timber.

In pursuance of their powers under the above act, the Council hereby PERMIT the above development to be carried out in accordance with the following Conditions:

C1 The development hereby authorised shall be begun not later than three years from the date of this consent.

Reason: In accordance with the requirements of Section 18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 (as amended).

C2 Prior to the commencement of the approved development, a scheme including details of the means/location of disposal of all demolition material and all waste arising from building works, shall be submitted to and agreed in writing with the Planning Authority. The development shall thereafter proceed in strict accordance with the approved scheme unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Planning Authority.

Reason: This is a pre-commencement condition that requires details that were not submitted as part of the application, but are required to fully understand the impact upon landscape and management of waste, to be submitted and agreed by the Local Planning Authority. This is to ensure those characteristics which contribute to the status of the Isles of Scilly as a Conservation Area, Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and Heritage Coast are not eroded by uncontrolled mineral extraction or the tipping of waste. In accordance with the requirements of Policy 1 of the Isles of Scilly Local Plan 2005

C3 The development hereby approved shall be carried out in accordance with the approved application details only including those identified:

- a) Drawing: Upper Flat Riviera House (Frame Configuration)
- b) Photograph: Upper Flat Riviera House (Windows to be replaced)
- c) Details: General Specification

All stamped Approved and dated 7th July 2015

Reason: To define the nature and extent of the development and for the avoidance of doubt

Further Information

- 1 In dealing with this application, the Council of the Isles of Scilly has actively sought to work with the applicants in a positive and proactive, in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the NPPF.
- 2 In accordance with the Town and Country Planning (fees for Application and Deemed Applications) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2008 a fee is payable to discharge any condition(s) on this planning permission. The fee is £28 for each request to discharge condition(s) and it is payable for each individual request made to the Local Planning Authority.
- 3 In accordance with the provisions of Section 96A of the Town and Country Planning Act which came into force on 1st October 2009, any amendments to the approved plans will require either a formal application for a non-material amendment (for which a fee of £28 would be required) or the submission of a full planning application for a revised scheme. If the proposal relates to a Listed Building you will not be able to apply for a non-material amendment and a new application for a revised scheme will be required. Please discuss any proposed amendments with the Planning Officer.
