Environmental Health Response.

The application details the installation of a ground source heat pump. Plans/ supporting documents do not specify the location of a ground source heat pump and it is not possible to determine if installation would give rise to any potential noise disturbance.

Noise and dust control

The applicant should take all relevant precautions to minimise the potential for disturbance to the occupiers of neighbouring properties in terms of noise and dust during the demolition and construction phases of the development. This should include not working outside regular day time hours, the use of water suppression for any stone or brick cutting and advising neighbours in advance of any particularly noisy works. The granting of this planning permission does not indemnify against statutory nuisance action being taken should substantiated noise or dust complaints be received.
