- Within 28 days of the date of this permission detail of replacement lower wattage lightbulbs shall be C1 submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The brightness of the bulbs shall not exceed 600cd or equivalent. The existing bulbs shall be replaced with those approved within 28 days of the date of the written approval and shall be retained at the approved luminance level thereafter. Reason: To prevent the unnecessary spread of light pollution harming the amenity of the area and having a detrimental impact upon the wider AONB Designation, in accordance with Policy 1 of the Isles of Scilly Local Plan 2005.
- C2 The retention of lower luminance bulbs, hereby permitted, shall be subject to strict hours of operation including no usage after 11pm or before 4pm on any day. Reason: To prevent the unnecessary illumination harming the amenity of the area and having a detrimental

impact upon the wider AONB Designation, in accordance with Policy 1 of the Isles of Scilly Local Plan 2005.
