Reason: To ensure those characteristics which contribute to the status of the Isles of Scilly as a Conservation Area, Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and Heritage Coast are not eroded by uncontrolled mineral extraction or the tipping of waste. In accordance with the requirements of Policy 1 of the Isles of Scilly Local Plan 2005.

C3 Prior to their installation on the building hereby approved, details including samples of the natural slate to be used on the roof of the building, shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Planning Authority. The development shall thereafter be carried out in accordance with the approved details.

Reason: To confirm details of the development not already clearly shown in the interests of the character and appearance of the building.

C4 Prior to the commencement of the development, hereby approved, an Ecological Survey of the roof materials and loft space must be conducted. The survey report must be submitted to and agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority and any recommendations carried out before the scantle is removed.

Reason: This is a pre-commencement condition that requires details that were not submitted as part of the application, but are required to fully understand the impact upon a statutorily protected species and the wildlife, geographical and geomorphological interest and features of designated Sites of Special Scientific Interest; and locally important biodiversity habitats, species and landscape features, is to be submitted to the Local Planning Authority. This is to ensure those characteristics which contribute to the status of the Isles of Scilly as a Conservation Area, Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and Heritage Coast are protected. In accordance with the requirements of Policy 1 of the Isles of Scilly Local Plan 2005
