PRE-INSTALLATION - SUBMISSION OF SAMPLES/DETAILS OF ROOF SLATES

Prior to their installation, a sample of the roof slates and a sample of the timber cladding for the elevations of the building, hereby permitted, shall be submitted to and agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The building shall be constructed in accordance with the approved materials thereafter.

Reason: In the interests of the character and appearance of the Conservation Areas, Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and Heritage Coast in accordance with Policy 1 of the Isles of Scilly Local Plan 2005.

RETENTION OF BOUNDARY HEDGES

The boundary hedges within the red lined area of the development, hereby approved, shall be retained at a minimum height of 2 metres, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The hedges shall remain at or higher than the agree height thereafter.

Reason: In the interests of the character and appearance of the Conservation Areas, Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and Heritage Coast in accordance with Policy 1 of the Isles of Scilly Local Plan 2005.
