# Listed Buildings

The listed buildings identified within the surroundings of the proposal are all of Church Street and are out of site of the proposed development

#### Scheduled Monument

The site is within sight of the scheduled monument on Buzza Hill. However, the proposed development is nestled within existing buildings comprising the relatively recent development at Porthcressa including the library, shops and housing. The photovoltaic modules that make up the roof of the canopy will have a high quality non-reflective finish that will match the already installed modules on the nearby Porthcressa flats. The proposed development will have little or no impact on this scheduled monument.

# Archeological Constraints and Find Spots
