The tree holds some amenity value within the Carn Thomas area and is visible from Telegraph Road to the north and to some extent, Moorwell Lane to the east. The applicant proposes to remove the tree for reasons of the impact it is having on the adjacent property at Turnstones, with roots interfering with the foundations and drainage of this site. The tree is visible but it is not a native tree species and overall it is not considered to be worthy of a Tree Preservation Order due to its limited amenity value, and importance to the wider character of the conservation area. It is therefore considered that the LPA raise no objection to the removal of the tree as proposed.
