

Heritage Impact Assessment – Installation of Electric Vehicle Charging Points at:

Site 52, Schiller Shelter / Tourist Information Centre

Listed Buildings

The post medieval Town Hall buildings sits across the car park from the proposed site. The nature of the proposals means that they will not be seen in the same context as this building and will therefore have no impact on their special architectural or historical interest or setting.

There are no other listed buildings within site of the proposed electric charger location.

Scheduled Monument

There are no scheduled monuments within the vicinity of the proposed site.

Non-designated Heritage Assets

There are two sites identified on the Cornwall & Isles of Scilly Heritage Environment Record in the immediate vicinity of the site that are neither Listed or Scheduled. These are:

- The Parade – a post medieval parade ground containing the site of a post medieval find spot and a medieval cross (remains off).
- Porthcressa – early medieval find spot, site of a modern pillbox and site of a post medieval shipyard on Porthcressa beach.

The nature of the proposals means that they will not be seen in the same context as these non-designated heritage assets and will therefore have no impact on their special architectural or historical interest or setting.
