Thank you for re-consulting us on this application. We have consulted the submitted Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) (Steve Harding 25/11/2021). While the submitted HIA does not meet the expected standards, it does include further information about the proposed development which can be used to guide our advice.

In terms of the connection for the wastewater, in this instance, we consider it unlikely that significant archaeological remains will be disturbed by groundworks. No archaeological mitigation is required, and therefore no archaeological condition is sought.

In relation to the raising of the ridgeline of the building we consider that this will result in a negligible impact on the setting of Ennor Castle, a Scheduled Monument (NHLE 1014994; MCO30370).
