Thank you for consulting us on this application. We have consulted the Cornwall & Isles of Scilly Historic Environment Record, and in particular, the results of archaeological evaluation and geophysical survey undertaken prior to the construction of the school site (Johns, Sturgess and Shepherd 2010), which revealed no significant archaeological features. The application site has been already been extensively disturbed by ground disturbance for the development of the existing school buildings (Design and Access Statement, figure 4 – note terracing). Therefore, in this instance, we consider it unlikely that significant archaeological remains will be disturbed by groundworks. No archaeological mitigation is required, and therefore no archaeological condition is sought.
