Hi Eddie,

A planning application for the extension and change of use of the Town Hall went to Full Council last month but has been deferred with plans now amended to reduce the scale of the development a little.

We didn't consult with Highways on the application initially but in discussion Members did raise a matter around potential highway safety (apologies I don't have minutes or a link to the discussion). As a result, we are consulting with you on the plans should you have any comments to make. The main point was whether the junction from The Parade turning towards Porthcressa would be impacted on at all but comments on the extension of the building out to the main highway around that back corner (across the fixed trading sites) would be welcome too.
