Dear Sirs/ Mesdames,

I am writing to object to the above application concerning a take-away food outlet on Holgates Green, Hugh Town, which will involve a change of use from an open public area. Whilst I feel we need more food outlets for visitors, this cannot be at the expense of our limited community space - not only is the area used for public functions such as the World Gig Championships, charity fundraising events, a picnic area etc. but given its proximity to Town Beach and the outstanding views out to sea, it is very popular with both locals and visitors particularly during the summer months and at times when the food take-away would operate. The islands will suffer in so many ways if activities have to be curtailed for space, health and safety reasons etc. and I am very concerned that this precedent will result in other outlets requesting space too, resulting in the closure of the area to all its many present uses.

For all these reasons, the application should be rejected.
