Whilst I would support the extra provision of Fast Food outlets during the visitor season this is a valuable green space overlooking the Harbour to be preserved for us all . Change of use will inevitably lead to further applications. Please consider offering alternative sites in the planning of the Town Hall development.

The present Park area in the centre is under used , due to the narrow difficult accesses for wheelchairs, pushchairs and others with mobility problems , a very uneven surface and often muddy and wet entrances The Farmers Market has already proved to be an great asset to Islanders and visitors and deserves improved facilities. This whole area lends itself to be developed with provision made for all street traders . Please reconsider for future generations!
