Dear Planning dept,

I am writing to offer my support for the Smalley's planning application to operate a takeaway food stall on Holgates Green for the following reasons....

1. There is no reason not to allow this, other than a few people resistant to change don't like the idea
2. I believe the council will be asking the two take away enterprises currently operating at the rear of the town hall to vacate that area and move to Holgates Green once work starts on the new Museum, so it seems only fair and sensible to allow this new start up to start from this location
3. There is little enough choice for visitors to eat out as it is unless you like chips and pizza, so anything that provides a diversity of choice should be encouraged
4. Considering that Holgates Green is used for all manner of public events throughout the year, I see no reason not to allow takeaway stalls to be able to trade from this location. In fact by centering all take away food outlets on Holgates Green this will provide a central point around which visitors and families could congregate of an evening to enjoy a meal with decent views and facilities, e.g. the existing public toilets, seated benches and rubbish bins.
5. Anyone who would not like to participate in the above can always walk the 50yds to one of the many benches further along the strand.
