Following consideration of the Isles of Scilly Sea Defence plans, please see below for our response.

MMO Marine Planning response to the consultation on the Isles of Scilly Sea Defences.

I hope you received our standard response to your initial email.

Please consider these further comments regarding the Sea Defences consultation documents. We advise that you take note of any relevant policies within the [South West Marine Plan](#) documents in regard to areas within the Sea Defences consultation plan that may impact upon the marine environment. **Some examples of marine plan policies that may be relevant include: Infrastructure (p.33), Climate Change Resilience and Adaptation (p.177), and Disturbance (p.308).** These are provided only as a recommendation, and we suggest you make your own determination of which are relevant. Our policies can be referred to as a guide, demonstrating your regard to the marine plans, under the [Marine and Coastal Access Act, 2009](#). It is important to note that marine plan policies do not work in isolation, and decision-makers should consider a whole-plan approach. You may also want to explore our [Explore Marine Plans tool](#) to better visualise and understand relevant environmental designations, marine licence data, policy information from marine plans, habitats of interest and areas of infrastructure.

You may consider mentioning the [South West Marine Plan](#) when discussing coastal or marine themes.

Any developments that will affect the marine and coastal area will require a marine licence, information on this can be found [here](#), and for any future information in relation to this consultation I recommend speaking to the marine licencing team directly.
