Tresco Estate Partnership owns and operates Hell Bay Hotel, we had a meeting with Stephen Swabey and the Council's contractor in Early January where we were assured that although the works would impinge slightly on the early part of the season they would in no way impact on the core season.

Hell Bay Hotel is the largest business on Bryher and is important for supporting the other smaller businesses across the Island. Hell Bay Hotel will be directly impacted by the delays and it will potentially cost the Estate several million pounds as the works are directly outside the hotel and on surrounding beaches through May to September.

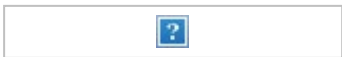
I would like to reiterate Amy's concerns and insist on detailed method statements, detailed programme of works and deliveries, traffic management plans, details of all proposed mitigations and an open and honest conversation about compensation.

Are the timeframes restricted by the grant – EA and ERDF – is there any chance of a grant extension to allow the works to be done later in the year?
