Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

REFERENCE:

P/22/083/TWA

WORKS PROPOSED:

Reduce height of 1x Mature Elm, 1x Mature Ash and 1x Pine to prevent shading to the property known as Watermill House and to prevent large falling branches from causing damage to the property and garden.

LOCATION:

Watermill House, Watermill, St Mary's

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 6th December 2022. I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold some amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council does not intend to protect these trees further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the tree. The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
