With reference to the above application I consider, if the chimney concerned for removal is in any way unsafe or in need of repair. Then it may be removed, but to do so just for the purpose of removal is not necessary nor needed. The only benefit from removal would be for cosmetic sight improvement. I do not consider the chimney as at present in any way obstructs sight lines - but it was designed and intended. Removal would not I believe in any way improve sight of the building as at present - from any view. I consider removal would be contrary to General Objectives of Planning Department Document "Traditional Farm Buildings Isles of Scilly" which generally advocates retention of small farms and buildings as redolent of cottages and barns on the Isles - please refer to document 1995-1997.
