We strongly object to the suggestion of allowing takeaway vans to be parked on Holgate's Green.

It is a lovely spot for people to sit and enjoy the view of the harbour, and for community events. Holgate's Green is uniquely placed to enjoy a tranquil moment without the distractions of everyday noise and disruption.

Our Islands are being steadily ruined by people trying to make them like the mainland.

Our objections also include:

noise pollution from the electricity generator;

close proximity to residential properties;

loss of recreational amenity;

smell;

large gathering of crowds at the busiest periods;

litter control and management places a heavy burden on local ratepayers;

Unrestricted and uncontrolled opening times in the rush to maximise profits will further impact this unique green space.
