Having looked at the relevant documents on the Council's website, including the photo and applicants' submission, I am writing to strongly object to this application.

The large Land Rover and food trailer would be unsightly and totally inappropriate in this location. Already the road alongside Holgates is blighted by parked vehicles and to allow food outlets onto the green would certainly not "enhance the tourist provision and contribute to improving the visitor experience" as stated by the applicants.

Visitors and locals have always enjoyed the green amenity and the stunning views across Town Beach and beyond. They must be allowed to continue to enjoy the view without the encumbrance of vehicles, trailers, generators etc. blocking views, and considerably reducing the area in which they can sit on benches & at picnic tables.

People queuing for food would also take up valuable space and once one application is passed, it would just be a matter of time before other vendors are given permission.

The Council must realise that Hugh Town and the surrounding area - including the Strand - is fast becoming highly congested, unattractive and is *not so gradually* changing the nature of our beautiful island. I am sure regular visitors who value the peace and quiet of Scilly are already disgruntled at the number of vehicles in town and this application will only make this worse.
