Thank you for consulting us on this application on this Grade II Listed Building (NHL 1328825). We have consulted the Cornwall & Isles of Scilly Historic Environment Record and the submitted documents including the Heritage Statement (Ridgeway 15/08/2023) and, in this instance, we consider it unlikely that the proposed alterations will disturb significant fabric or diminish the building's historic significance. In addition, the creation of the garage will require negligible ground disturbance in an area of low archaeological potential.

We therefore advise that no archaeological or historic building recording is required, and that no archaeological condition is sought.
