### Listed Buildings

There are no listed buildings within the vicinity of the proposed site.

### Scheduled Monuments

The closest scheduled monuments to the proposed site range in distance from 150m to 290m. These are clustered to the east/south-east of the site adjacent to the Higher Moors & Porth Hellick Pool SSSI. The proposed developments will not be visible from the vicinity of any of these scheduled monuments and therefore will have no impact on their special architectural or historical interest or setting.



### Non-designated Heritage Assets

The find spots in the vicinity of the proposed development are located to the north and east of the site. Archaeological constraint sites are located to the north-west, east and south-west of the development. All sites are at a reasonable distance from the proposed development and it will be only minimally visible from them and will be seen in the context of the agricultural land surrounding it and not in the context of these heritage assets. There are no Heritage Assets on the proposed site itself.

### SSSI

The Higher Moors & Porth Hellick Pool SSSI is located 120m from the proposed development. Compliance with Animal By-Products legislation requires that all liquid waste from the In-Vessel Composting process must be disposed of through mains drainage. Since the site is not mains connected, all liquid waste will be directly piped from the composter to an IBC container which will be emptied periodically by an established local contractor with the waste then safely and compliantly disposed of through the mains waste water treatment system on St Mary's. This will ensure that no waste from the composting process is released into the environment on the site, and therefore ensures that there will be no impact from pollution on the SSSI.
