(Comments)

The existing proposal does not appear to meet the vehicle access requirements within ADB Vol B5 which requires access to all parts of the development by a pumping appliance to be within 45mtrs as the fire hose is laid and subsequently the location of the proposed building may need reviewing.

The Fire Authority would advise that evidence should be provided as part of the application to the Isles of Scilly planning department clearly demonstrating compliance with B5 within the Building Regulations before the application is determined.

The Fire Authority would then make further comment/observations on vehicle access should the information be provided and if required by the planning department.

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The fire authority would also remind the applicant should either the proposed development or the existing property [number 4] be used for paying guests, even for just 1 day the requirements of the Regulatory Reform [Fire Safety] Order 2005 must be met.

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A Building Regulations consultation with the local authority, or an Approved Inspector will be required for this development should planning permission be granted.
