**Waste**: - Any waste should be securely stored within the boundary of the property and placed out on the highway on the day of collection.

The plans should include the provision of secure waste and recycling storage sizeable enough to accommodate segregated recycling within the boundary of the property, taking into account both current and future waste requirements laid out in the Government's Environment Act, 2021.

Any waste derived from the proposed alterations (other than Rubble, Concrete Blocks, Bricks, Plasterboard and Soil which are not excepted at the Porthmellon Waste and Recycling facility) would become commercial (if contractors are carrying out the works) and as such would require a commercial waste site permit to enter the Porthmellon Waste and Recycling facility during commercial opening times (if being brought in by the contractors) with the relevant disposal fee being charged.
