Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

REFERENCE: P/24/001/TWA
WORKS PROPOSED: Pollarding of 5 no. elm trees on the north boundary and 3 no. elm trees on the south boundary.
LOCATION: Vale View Cottage, Maypole, St Mary's

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 9th January 2024. I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works which have been assessed as appropriate.
