Highways – there isn't a pavement available for pedestrians outside of this facility, other than from the police station. Sufficient area should be provided within the curtilage of the property and proposed development to ensure pedestrians can safely wait/queue without having to queue on the highway.

Parking – there is no provision for parking as part of this proposed development. Parking in this area is limited due to the number of parked cars and the narrow street.
