Thank you for consulting us on this application. We have consulted the Cornwall & Isles of Scilly Historic Environment Record (HER) and the submitted documents including the agricultural justification and landscaping scheme (Stideford and Son nd) which outline the groundworks involved.

The HER notes that within 70m of the application site three Romano-British cist graves have been recorded (MCO45369), and geophysical survey in the adjacent field (to the east) suggests further potential archaeological features.

However, due to the limited proposed ground disturbance to create a level platform for the construction of the concrete pad, in this instance, we consider it unlikely that significant archaeological remains will be disturbed by groundworks. No archaeological mitigation is required, and therefore no archaeological condition is sought.
