Identification of Tree(s) and Description of Works

Minor pruning of trees to the entrance of the site and western boundary to provide access for construction plant. Trees to be pruned along the northern fence line of the site are English Elm (as shown in red in Appendix B-F). Trees within the woodland are Monterey Pine with an understorey

of Karo Scrub (as shown in blue in Appendix B-F).

Pruning of Monterey Pine along the western extent of the site (shown in Appendix B). Branches will be pruned a maximum of 2-3m to the hedgerow

and will not be cut further than required. Limbs will be severed to be able to grow back. No works will be undertaken to the trees trunks.

Removal of one fallen tree to the west of the site (as shown in Appendix G) for health and safety. This tree will be inspected for bat presence prior to

removal.

Pruning of the trees will ensure traffic can safely enter the site without damaging the limbs of the overhanging trees and to ensure adequate heath

and safety on site.

The works are planned for w/c 11th March 2024.

Pruning will be undertaken by Trant Engineering Limited in-line with the controls prescribed in Appendix G.

Limbs will be pruned as per below:

- -Work area to be established to prevent unauthorised access
- Site team to be briefed with scope of work
- Limbs to be pruned using hand tools
- No section of the trunk is to be removed or pruned during the works
- Pruned limbs are to be removed from site and disposed of appropriately

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
