Environment Agency Position

We have no objection to this planning application from a flood risk perspective, subject to the inclusion of the following conditions:

Condition

• The planning permission for this temporary development must be limited to 4 years from the point of granting of permission. From this date, the development should either be returned to its original condition, or the flood risk should be reevaluated. The Environment Agency would request to be re-consulted, should the development required a longer lifespan.

Condition

- All Mitigation Measures referenced within the Flood Risk Assessment (Document Ref: TMS0002727, dated March 2024) on page 6, must be adhered to. These include:
- The site will register with the EA flood warning service.
- Site services, particularly electrical facilities shall be located off the ground level, and even above the raised floor level of the units.
- An Emergency Evacuation Plan shall be provided to the residents of the units.
- Construction materials for the project delivery will be stored locally to the specific work
