As there will be a perimeter fence erected around the Town Hall it must be ensured access for the fire service remains at least within

The 45mtrs to all parts of the premises as required by Building Regulations.

We would advise additional pedestrian gateways on top of the vehicle gateway proposed are installed in the perimeter fence where

There is an entrance/exit door to the Town Hall.

Keys or codes required to access all gateways to the perimeter fence should be given to the local fire service so access can be gained in the event of a fire

When the site is not operating.
