Access for fire appliances within the site will be considered satisfactory providing it complies with Part B5 of Approved Document B, Vehicle Access.

As the proposal seeks to provide sleeping accommodation for longer than 28 days the fire authority would advise the applicant a Building Regulations consultation with the local authority, or an Approved Inspector will be required should planning permission be granted.

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The Fire Authority should also be consulted as part of the Building Regulations application to ensure compliance with The Regulatory Reform [Fire Safety] Order 2005.
