Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

WORKS PROPOSED: Pollard a number of mature Elm trees to a height of 15ft to ensure healthy growth

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 07 August 2024.
