## Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

**REFERENCE:** P/24/066/TWA  
**WORKS PROPOSED:** Crown lift of approximately 30 mature Elms to allow for additional light and health of trees  
**LOCATION:** Land At Junction of Parting Carn Lane/Telegraph Road, Parting Carn, St Mary's, Isles Of Scilly

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 16 August 2024. I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works which have been assessed as appropriate.
