Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

WORKS PROPOSED:

Crown reduction of large Elm in garden of Heugh House, removal of 2 large limbs and overhanging branches of Elm tree in garden of Tamarisk, pollard 11 Elms to 6 foot rear of Hugh House.

LOCATION:

Hugh House, The Garrison, St Mary's, Isles Of Scilly, TR21 0LS,

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 4th November 2024. I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold some amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees.
