We have consulted the Cornwall & Isles of Scilly Historic Environment Record, the supporting documents and the further information provided by the applicant to the LPA via email (03/03/2025) and, in this instance, we consider it unlikely that significant archaeological remains will be disturbed by the proposed scheme. No archaeological mitigation is required, and therefore no archaeological condition is sought.

* The application site is immediately adjacent to a Second World War pillbox, which is a Scheduled Monument (NHL 1016517).
