I would like to object to this planning application. First, I am sorry if I a bit late, but I did not see the notice since it was posted on the side of the chandlery behind a hedge, rather than in a prominent place. The assertion is that this will be for employees on a permanent basis, yet there is no explanation of this. Hither too this site has been for seasonal work, there is never anyone there through the winter. Mr Andrews and his family do not reside at the site on a permanent basis, I only see the family in short periods of time now ad again, Mr Andrews himself does not reside on the site all season. In the application Mr Coupe has ticked that the site is not visible from a public road, this is not true, it will be visible from outside my house.

I guess that the increase in staff has something to do with Mr Andrews attempt to introduce jet skis to Silly, which I and many other people are opposed to. These containers will also be visible from the beach and sea - hedges don't grow overnight, and in themselves obstruct views. We also have drainage issues on this side of the Island, and these units will be below our septic tank. I already have a field full of boats in front of me, there was no change of use application for that as far as I am aware and enough is enough
